

## GLOSSARY

- **Cell** – basic unit of life which living organisms consist.
  - **Unicellular** – organisms made up of one cell only.
  - **Multicellular** – organisms made up of many cells.
  - **Tissue** – a group of cells with similar shape that work together to perform a particular function.
  - **Organ** – a group of tissues that work together to perform a function.
  - **System** – a group of organs that work together to perform a specific task.
  - **Organism** – the result of several systems working together in a coordinated way.
  - **Specialised** – when a structure is modified to perform special function.
  - **Cell division** – when cells divide to make more cells.
  - **Mitosis** – a type of cell division that takes place when one cell repeatedly divides.
  - **Differentiation** – the process when cells are structurally different to perform a particular function.
